**AN ORDINANCE HIRING SEASONAL POLICE OFFICERS FOR 2022 AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Council have determined that it is necessary to hire more seasonal police officers for 2021; and

WHEREAS, Council has further determined that the hiring of seasonal police officers for 2021 is a matter of local self-government and thus essential to the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of and the visitors to the Village of Kelley’s Island.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
VILLAGE OF KELLEYS ISLAND, COUNTY OF ERIE AND STATE OF OHIO AS
FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. That James Bartus II, James D. Blodgett, Justin Boswell, Teresa Campbell, Philip Couch, Dan McFaul, Amber Sonnie and Jack Wade are hereby hired as a seasonal police officer for 2022 at a salary of \$18.00/Hour effective January 1, 2022 and terminating December 31, 2022 until duly changed by the Village Council. Also, new hire/trainee Chevy M. Farmer is hereby hired as a seasonal police officer for 2022 at a salary of \$15.00/hour effective January 1, 2022 and terminating December 31, 2022 until duly changed upon notification to the Mayor from the Police Chief that said individuals training period has ended.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of Kelleys Island concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of such body, and that all deliberations of the Council of the Village of Kelleys Island and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall be adopted as an emergency measure to take effect immediately upon its adoption and due authentication by the Mayor and the Clerk, respectively, and for the further reason that is necessary to hire these officers immediately for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Kelleys Island, Ohio, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-O- 23

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CLERK-TREASURER TO MAKE CERTAIN APPROPRIATIONS INTO CERTAIN FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

INTRODUCED BY: COUNCILMAN GREG RITCHIE

WHEREAS, Members of Council have passed legislation that will allow them to have control over spending; and

WHEREAS, Members of Council will have authority over purchases within monetary limits by virtue of appropriations; and

WHEREAS, certain funds do not have appropriations sufficient to end the fiscal year of December 31st, 2021; and

WHEREAS, there exists unappropriated cash to the credit of those funds; and

WHEREAS, monies must be appropriated before they can be used; and

WHEREAS, the Erie County Auditor has given the Village a Certificate of Estimated Resources that covers the requested appropriation or has been sent a request for an Amended Certificate of Estimated Resources which will cover the proposed appropriation request; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF KELLEYS ISLAND, COUNTY OF ERIE AND STATE OF OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to appropriate additional monies in the following funds to increase the 2021 appropriations as stated below:

To increase the Water Fund by \$20,000 (from \$600,000 to \$620,000).

SECTION 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of Kelleys Island concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of such body, and that all deliberations of the Council of the Village of Kelleys Island and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: That for the reasons set forth in the preamble, this Ordinance shall be deemed an emergency measure and shall be effective immediately upon its adoption and due authentication by the Mayor and Clerk, respectively.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A BASE RATE SALARY RANGE FOR PAID FULL-TIME AND PART-TIME PERMANENT EMPLOYEES, ESTABLISHING COST OF LIVING INCREASES, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO: 2020-0-35

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Council have determined that it is necessary to update the base salary ranges for the paid full-time and part-time permanent employees and establish cost of living increases for all paid full and part-time employees whether paid by salary or hourly and;

WHEREAS, Council has further determined that he establishment of compensation for village employees is a matter of local self-government and that updating a base salary range for the various positions of the Village is necessary for the efficient operation of the office of the Clerk-Treasurer and is thus essential to the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of and the visitors to the Village of Kelleys Island.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF KELLEYS ISLAND, COUNTY OF ERIE AND STATE OF OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the base rate salary range for the various positions of the Village are listed as Exhibit “A” which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten.

SECTION 2. These positions shall be subject to withholding in the Public Employee Retirement System (OPERS) and the Village shall be authorized to deduct the necessary amount prescribed by law from each salary payment and the Village shall pay its contribution to P.E.R.S. based upon each salary payment.

SECTION 3. All salaried and hourly full-time and part-time permanent employees will receive cost of living increases with the first pay period of the year based on the CPI index previously adopted by Council provided the CPI index number is not of negative value. The cost of living increase for 2022 shall be applied retroactively to the first full pay period of the year. This Ordinance shall become effective January 1, 2022

SECTION 4. Council reserves the right to raise the rate of pay for any full or part-time permanent employees by motion, provided the base rate of pay does not exceed the range established where applicable.

SECTION 5. Ordinance No. 2020 - O -35 is hereby repealed effective December 31, 2021

SECTION 6. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of Kelleys Island concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of such body, and that all deliberations of the Council of the Village of Kelleys Island and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 7. That this Ordinance shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
