

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-O- 01

INTRODUCED BY COUNCIL MEMBER A. MAX EATON

ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF KELLEYS ISLAND, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2022, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Section 1. BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Kelleys Island, State of Ohio, that, to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the said Village of Kelleys Island during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2022, the following sums be and they are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows, viz:

The Village Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized to make payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefor, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. Provided further that any appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village, and for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 7. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Kelleys Island and for the further reason, that it is imperative that the Village pass and send the permanent appropriations for 2022 to the Erie County Auditor before the April 1st deadline per R.C. 5705.38, therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
