**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE FOREST LANE WATERLINE AND
EASEMENT IN THE VILLAGE OF KELLEYS ISLAND, OHIO**

WHEREAS, the Village of Kelleys Island, Ohio desires to expand its public water system one way to accomplish said expansion is by accepting waterlines and waterline easements.

WHEREAS, John Kuyoth, Robert Gosselin and John Malene desire to grant to the Village of Kelleys Island, Ohio, a waterline and waterline easement for the use, maintenance, operation, repair and replacement of its waterline known as the Forest Lane Waterline.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF KELLEYS ISLAND, COUNTY OF ERIE AND STATE OF OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the Village of Kelleys Island does hereby accept a waterline and waterline easement from John Kuyoth, Robert Gosselin, and John Malene in the area described in Exhibit A and illustrated in a plat drawing and legal description labeled Exhibit B both attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten.

SECTION 2. That the Clerk of Council is instructed to endorse the acceptance upon the easement and record it in the Office of the County Recorder of Erie County.

SECTION 3. That the funds needed for this transaction are hereby appropriated or will be appropriated.

SECTION 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the Village of Kelleys Island concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of such body, and that all deliberations of the Council of the Village and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance shall be in effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
