AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2005-O-6 REQUIRING THE VILLAGE TO PICK-UP THE POLICE CHIEFS' MANDATORY CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE OHIO POLICE AND FIRE PENSION FUND.

WHEREAS, The Village Council in 2005 adopted a pickup of the mandatory employee contributions required under Section 742.31 of the Ohio Revised Code for a full-time police Chief who was a member of the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund (“OP&F”); and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to repeal this Ordinance as a house cleaning measure as there has not been a full-time Police Chief on Kelley Island for 17 years and moreover its application would be fiscally irresponsible.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF KELLEYS ISLAND, COUNTY OF ERIE AND STATE OF OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No.2005-O-6 is hereby repealed the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of Kelleys Island concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of such body, and that all deliberations of the Council of the Village of Kelleys Island and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
