ORDINANCE NO. 2022 – O - 12

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO DONATE THE KELLEYS ISLAND POLICE BOAT, MOTORS AND TRAILER TO THE SANDUSKY POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in 2009 pursuant to the Northern Border Initiative the Homeland Security Task Force donated to the Village of Kelleys Island a Boston Whaler Justice Watercraft equipped with two (2) two hundred horsepower Evinrude motors and trailer.

WHEREAS, The Village of Kelleys Island does no longer intend to use said watercraft for police purposes and the City of Sandusky Police Department has expressed an interest in acquiring it by donation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF KELLEYS ISLAND, COUNTY OF ERIE AND STATE OF OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to donate the 24 foot Boston Whaler ID # BWCLA158D797, 200 horsepower Evinrude Motors ID#s 0516006 and 05171732 and a Boat Master Trailer ID# 42XBB2427UF007071, to the City of Sandusky Police Department.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of Kelleys Island concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of such body, and that all deliberations of the Council of the Village of Kelleys Island and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Kelleys Island, and for the further reason that boating season has commenced and for the Sandusky Police Department to get any use out of the boat this year they need the boat to train immediately, therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
