ORDINANCE NO. 2022 – O - 13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 78 ENTITLED “PARKING SCHEDULES” AND 76.99 ENTITLED “PENALTY” OF THE KELLEYS ISLAND CODIFIED ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, the purpose of this amendment is to update this section of the code to properly deal with the changing landscape and traffic of Kelleys Island.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF KELLEYS ISLAND, COUNTY OF ERIE AND STATE OF OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1:

That Chapter 78 Schedule 1 (A) which presently prohibits parking on the east side of Division Street from the Police Station to Chappel Street, and does not address parking north of 123 Division Street

Is hereby amended by adding the following parking prohibitions;

On Division Street East, no parking from the Police Station North to Bookerman Rd. and on Division Street West no parking from 123 Division Street North to Bookerman Rd.

SECTION 2.

That Section 76.99 entitled “Penalty” which reads as follows;

Whoever violates any provisions of this Chapter 78, Sched.1, except & 76.05 (A) , (C), (F) or (H), shall, upon conviction, be fined \$15.00 if paid within 72 hours after issuance of the citation. After the expiration of 72 hours, the fine shall be increase to \$30.00

Is hereby amended as follows;

Whoever violates any provisions of this Chapter 78, Sched.1, except & 76.05 (A), (C), (F) or (H), shall, upon conviction, be fined **\$50.00** if paid within 72 hours after issuance of the citation. After the expiration of 72 hours, the fine shall be increase to **\$100.00**

SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of Kelleys Island concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of such body, and that all deliberations of the Council of the Village of Kelleys Island and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance shall be in effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
