**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CLERK/TREASURER TO PAY INVOICES  
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,596.73 TO RS&H FROM THE FAA-AIRPORT  
IMPROVEMENT FUND # 4201 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, RS&H have sent in invoices to the Clerk/Treasurer for conducting airport related environmental assessments in the amount of \$25,596.73 to be paid from the FAA Airport Improvement Grant Fund; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF KELLEYS ISLAND, COUNTY OF ERIE AND STATE OF OHIO AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Clerk/Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay invoices in the amount of \$25,596.73 to be paid from the FAA-Airport Improvement Fund # 4201.

**SECTION 2.** That the funds needed for this transaction are hereby appropriated or will be appropriated.

**SECTION 3.** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of Kelleys Island concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of such body, and that all deliberations of the Council of the Village of Kelleys Island and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 4.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Kelleys Island, and for the further reason that this Ordinance is require to be immediately effective in order to allow the Clerk/Treasurer the ability to pay outstanding bills to RS& H, wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
