ORDINANCE NO. 2022 – O - 30

INTRODUCED BY: MAYOR RONALD E EHRBAR

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE EPA REQUIRED WATER TESTING TO CAMP PATMOS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Camp Patmos has requested that the Village of Kelleys Island Water Department perform EPA required water testing for PH and Turbidity to be compliant with state law; and

WHEREAS, in order to be compliant a Class II operator must perform said tests.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF KELLEYS ISLAND, COUNTY OF ERIE AND STATE OF OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Camp Patmos to perform EPA water tests for pH and turbidity for 3 samples per day at \$10.00/day.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of Kelleys Island concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of such body, and that all deliberations of the Council of the Village of Kelleys Island and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Kelleys Island, and for the further reason that this Ordinance is require to be immediately effective in order to allow the Camp Patmos to be EPA compliant, wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

ORDINANCE 2022 - O - 31

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE MONTHS OF JANUARY, FEBRUARY, MARCH, 2023 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Introduced by Mayor Ronald Ehrbar

Whereas, the Clerk has advised Council that in order to provide for the usual daily operations of the Village departments that special appropriations for the months of January, February, and March of 2023 be made at once,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF KELLEYS ISLAND, OHIO:

Section 1. That there shall be, and hereby are, appropriated out of any monies now in the treasury or any accruing revenues of the Village available for said purpose except for Federal General Revenue Sharing Funds, the sum of money set forth in the column marked "Appropriations" for the payment of all expenses and obligations of the Village during the months of January, February, and March, 2023 for various purposes.

The amounts appropriated for various purposes shall, in no event, be exceeded unless the Village Council shall by ordinance appropriate additional unappropriated money or revenues.

Section 3. That, this Council hereby, finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of this Council and of its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code.

Section 4. That this ordinance is adopted pursuant to Section 5705.38 of the Ohio Revised Code, and shall be effective at the earliest date permitted by law.
