**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.13 SETTING FORTH THE PLACES  
WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF KELLEYS ISLAND FOR THE  
POSTING OF NOTICES AND ORDINANCES; REPEALING ANY AND ALL OTHER  
ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH**

**WHEREAS**, the requirement for the publication of ordinances and resolutions has been recently changed by the Ohio Legislature to allow for posting on the Villages web-site and therefore this section needs to be updated to allow for this type of posting.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF KELLEYS ISLAND, COUNTY OF ERIE AND STATE OF OHIO AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** § 10.13 entitled POSTING PLACES which reads as follows:

**§ 10.13 POSTING PLACES.**

The following places have been designated by Council:

- (A) Post office building, posting case;
- (B) Bulletin Board in Veterans Memorial Park;
- (C) Airport building, posting case;
- (D) Public Restrooms at Town Hall parking lot;
- (E) Clerk's office, bulletin board.

**SHALL BE AND IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:**

**§ 10.13 POSTING PLACES.**

The following places have been designated by Council:

- (A) Post office building, posting case;
- (B) Bulletin Board in Veterans Memorial Park;
- (C) Village web-site
- (E) Clerk's office, bulletin board..

**SECTION 2.** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of Kelleys Island concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of such body, and that all deliberations of the Council of the Village of Kelleys Island and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 3.** That this Ordinance shall be in effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
