RESOLUTION NO. 2024 – R - 02

AN RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO RENEW THE EXISTING 3.00 MILL LEVY TO PROVIDE FOR GENERAL CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, RESURFACING AND REPAIR OF STREETS, ROADS AND BRIDGES AND AUTHORIZING THE ERIE COUNTY AUDITOR TO CERTIFY TO THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF KELLEY ISLAND, OHIO THE TOTAL CURRENT TAX VALUATION OF THE VILLAGE OF KELLEY ISLAND, OHIO AND THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF REVENUE THAT WOULD BE GENERATED BY A RENEWAL TAX LEVY OF THREE AND 00/00 (3.00) MILLS AND FOR A RENEWAL TAX LEVY TO PROVIDE FOR GENERAL CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, RESURFACING AND REPAIR OF STREETS, ROADS AND BRIDGES PURSUANT TO RC SECTION 5705.19(G) CERTIFYING THE SAME TO THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS OF ERIE COUNTY, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Kelley Island has levied a tax, not exceeding 3.00 mills for each dollar of valuation, in excess of the 10-mill limitation to provide for General Construction, Reconstruction, Resurfacing and Repair of Streets, Roads and Bridges for five (5) years and such levy expires in tax year 2024 with collections ending in the year 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that, pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Sections 5709.19 and 5705.25, it is necessary to renew the existing 3.00 mill levy to provide for General Construction, Reconstruction, Resurfacing and Repair of Streets, Roads and Bridges; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it is necessary to place before the voters at the General Election to be held on November 5, 2024, the question of whether to approve a renewal tax levy to provide for General Construction, Reconstruction, Resurfacing and Repair of Streets, Roads and Bridges pursuant to R.C. Section 5705.19(G); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF KELLEY ISLAND, COUNTY OF ERIE AND STATE OF OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That the Council finds, determines and declares that the amount of taxes which may be raised by the Village of Kelley Island, Ohio by levies on the current tax duplicate within the 10-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide for the necessary requirements of the Village.

SECTION 2: That the Council further finds, determines and declares that pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5709.19 and 5709.25 it is necessary to levy a 3.00 mill levy for each \$1.00 of taxable value to provide for General Construction, Reconstruction, Resurfacing and Repair of Streets, Roads and Bridges for a period of five (5) years commencing with the 2025 tax duplicate, first to be distributed to the Village in the year 2026, and that it intends to submit the question of the renewal levy for current expenses to the electors of Kelley Island, wholly located in Erie County and levied on the entire territory of the Village of Kelley Island at the election of November 5, 2024.

SECTION 3: Under Section 5705.03 (B) of the Ohio Revised Code, the Village hereby requests the Erie County Auditor to certify to the Village the total current tax valuation of the Village, and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the 3.00 mill levy specified in Section 2.

SECTION 4: That the Clerk of this Council be, and she hereby is, directed to immediately certify a copy of this Ordinance to the Auditor of Erie County, Ohio, in order to obtain the information necessary to submit the within proposed renewal tax levy to the Board of Elections by the deadline for submission of candidates and ballot issues to be submitted to the electors of said Village at the general election to be held November 5, 2024.

SECTION 5: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the Village of Kelley Island concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of such body, and that all deliberations of the Council of the Village and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6: That for reasons set forth in the preamble, this Ordinance shall be adopted as an emergency measure to take effect immediately upon its adoption and due authentication by the Mayor and the Clerk, respectively, and in order to obtain the information necessary to submit the within proposed renewal tax levy to the Board of Elections by the deadline for submission of candidates and ballot issues to be submitted to the electors of said Village at the General Election to be held November 5, 2024
