The Village Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized to make payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefor, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. Provided further that any appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village, and for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 7. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Kelleys Island and for the further reason, that it is imperative that the Village pass and send the permanent appropriations for 2025 to the Erie County Auditor before the April 1st deadline per R.C. 5705.38, therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
