ORDINANCE NO. 2025 – O - 08

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CLERK-TREASURER TO INCREASE APPROPRIATIONS TO THE MCGETTIGAN, FERNWOOD, MEMORY (MFG) ASSESSMENT FUND FROM THE GENERAL FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,000.00 AND AUTHORIZING A TRANSFER OF \$ 25,000.00 FROM THE MFM ASSESSMENT FUND # 4501 TO CIVISTA LOAN ACCOUNT # 10042594 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Civista account # 10042594 is the account for making payments required to be made as a result of the MFM (Melody, Fernwood, Memory) Assessment, and therefore monies need to be transferred to make said payments.

WHEREAS, in order to transfer said funds it is necessary for the Clerk/Treasurer to increase the appropriations to the MFG assessment fund.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF KELLEYS ISLAND, COUNTY OF ERIE AND STATE OF OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the Village of Kelleys Island, Ohio does hereby authorize the Clerk /Treasurer to increase appropriations to the MFM assessment fund in the amount of \$25,000.00 and to transfer \$ 25,000.00 from MFM Assessment Fund #4501 to the Civista Loan Account # 10042594..

SECTION 2. That the funds needed for this transaction are hereby appropriated or will be appropriated.

SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the Village of Kelleys Island concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of such body, and that all deliberations of the Council of the Village of Kelleys Island and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Kelleys Island, and for the further reason that the payment from the MFM Assessment Fund is coming due, therefore, this Ordinance shall be in effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
