ORDINANCE NO. 2025 – O - 13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 92.02 ENTITLED “COST  
OF GRAVE SPACES” OF THE KELLEYS ISLAND CODIFIED  
ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, the purpose of this amendment is to update this section of the code to properly assist in the care and management of the municipal cemetery.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF KELLEYS ISLAND, COUNTY OF ERIE AND STATE OF OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

That Section 92.02 of the Kelleys island Codified Ordinances which states as follows:

(A) That as of January 1, 1989, all grave spaces of the village cemetery are to be sold and/or transferred at the rate of \$800 per space; \$600 for the lot and \$200 to be deposited in the Perpetual Care Fund, pursuant to R.C. § 759.12. Furthermore, as of August 11, 2022, all grave spaces of the village cemetery are to be sold and/or transferred at the rate of \$1,100 per space; \$800 for the lot and \$300 to be deposited in the Perpetual Care Fund pursuant to R.C. § 759.12.

Is hereby amended as follows;

(A) That as of January 15, 2026, all grave spaces of the village cemetery are to be sold and/or transferred at the rate of \$1300.00 per space; \$1000.00 for the lot and \$300 to be deposited in the Perpetual Care Fund pursuant to R.C. § 759.12.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of Kelleys Island concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of such body, and that all deliberations of the Council of the Village of Kelleys Island and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall be in effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
