ORDINANCE NO. 2025 – O - 22

A ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT
OF A PROSECUTOR FOR THE VILLAGE
OF KELLEYS ISLAND, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the Village of Kelleys Island Council desires to appoint Samuel Sidoti Prosecutor for the Village of Kelleys Island, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Prosecutor shall represent the Village in all criminal proceedings in court or before any administrative body; and

WHEREAS, the Prosecutor shall perform all other duties now or hereafter imposed upon village prosecutors by the general law of Ohio.

WHEREAS, the Prosecutor shall work for and report directly to the Village Solicitor.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF KELLEYS ISLAND, COUNTY OF ERIE AND STATE OF OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Samuel Sidoti shall be appointed as Prosecutor for the Village of Kelleys Island, Ohio from January 1, 2026 until December 31, 2027.

SECTION 2. That said Prosecutor shall receive the sum of \$18,000.00 per annum which shall be compensation in full for all of said Prosecutor services and or any employees of the Prosecutor, other than incidental costs associated with the performance of his duties, including but not limited to: ferry fees to and from Mayors Court proceedings, copying fees, recording fees, court costs associated with litigation, use of experts or any other expenses deemed relevant or important to the defense of or prosecution for the Village, its Mayor or Council members. Said position shall be subject to OPERS rules and regulations.

SECTION 3. That Samuel Sidoti is hereby appointed Prosecutor for the term set forth above.

SECTION 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of Kelleys Island concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of such body, and that all deliberations of the Council of the Village of Kelleys Island and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance shall be in effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
