I am pleased to share that the engineering phase of the project is moving forward with strong momentum. In addition, the Village has secured confirmation of a land swap with ODNR, allowing the new WWTP to be located northeast of downtown on Chappel Rd—a major step in the right direction.

Unfortunately, the initial Ohio EPA grant was not awarded to the Village, therefore we are actively pursuing additional funding opportunities with the U.S. Army Corps and various state/federal agencies. Once funding is secured the project will move to construction however this will likely not occur in 2026 as originally planned.

As progress continues, we remain committed to providing quarterly updates to keep all residents informed and involved. We truly appreciate your engagement and look forward to another wonderful season on the island. - Mayor Ron Ehrbar
